Portfolio Module – Scholarly Activity

New Innovations provides a portfolio module which allows real-time recording of scholarly activity throughout the academic year, which can then be reported to the ACGME during the annual WebADS review

Set-up:

In order to enter scholarly activity, forms must be set up to enter the information. As an example, one can set up six forms using NI templates as follows:

Abstracts
Chapters
Grants
National Presentations
Other Publications (non-peer reviewed)
Peer-Reviewed Publications

You can edit any of these or create one from scratch. The information required for each topic is different for each item. You can assign an ADS category for each one.

Entering Scholarly Activity

1. Log into New Innovations
2. Click on “Portfolio” at the top of the page
3. From the menu, select “Scholarly Activities”
4. Click on “New”
5. The “Log a Scholarly Activity” box appears
6. Select the type of activity you are logging
7. Click “Log the Selected Activity”
8. Fill in the form and save

In many cases, with the level of permissions that the faculty, fellows, and residents have, they are only able to log for themselves. The program coordinator can log for anyone in the department or division.
